- 1 in 8** People, including 1 in 8 children, struggles with hunger in Middle Tennessee
- 1 in 8** People, including 1 in 7 children, projected as food-insecure as a result of COVID-19 pandemic
- 346,830** Food-insecure individuals in our 46-county service area
- 381,980** Individuals projected as food-insecure as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic
- 46** Counties in our service area covering 20,712 square miles in Middle and West Tennessee
- 41,000,000** Pounds of food distributed
- 36,500,000** Meals provided
- 10,800,000** Pounds of fresh produce distributed
- 26** Percent of all food distributed by Second Harvest is fresh produce
- 7,000,000** Pounds of food rescued from 280 grocery stores through our grocery rescue program
- 71,323** Volunteer hours spent supporting our mission to feed hungry people and work to solve hunger issues in our community
- 1,900,000** Meals provided through our 16 Emergency Food Box locations
- 81,645** Individuals who received assistance through our Emergency Food Box program
- 273,764** Meals provided to families through 45 School Food Pantries
- 116,359** Meals and snacks provided through our Kids Cafe and At-Risk Afterschool meal programs to low-income children
- 5,805** Hungry children who received a bag of easy-to-prepare food through our Backpack Program to take home each weekend and during holidays
- 5,500,000** Meals provided through 263 large-scale, one-day Mobile Pantry food distributions hosted by churches and Partner Agencies in primarily rural communities
- 195,277** Individuals in needy families who were served at our Mobile Pantries
- 4** Meals Second Harvest can provide for our hungry neighbors with each \$1 donated (96¢ of each \$1 goes directly to our feeding programs)
