# You've Been a Lifeline to Loretha and Javier's Family

“This will help our family eat. Thank you!”

“It all happened at once,” Loretha says. “My work stopped. His work stopped. The money just stopped coming in.”

She earned an income selling handmade jewelry at craft shows and farmers markets, and her husband, Javier, worked as an engineer at local hotels. But since the pandemic hit, the couple has been missing paychecks and struggling to provide for their two boys, ages 13 and 14.

“We had a little bit of savings to help us get by

at first,” Javier says. “But you can't live off that.”

He's been looking at jobs in local warehouses but worries about the risk of exposure to COVID-19. One of his and Loretha's sons has severe respiratory issues, and the possibility of bringing the virus home to his family is a serious concern.

Like all of us, the couple looks forward to better days ahead for their family. In the meantime, they're grateful they can pick up healthy food from Glenclyff High School,

which partners with Second Harvest Food Bank of Middle Tennessee to share healthy groceries in southeast Nashville.

Friends like you have been bringing families like theirs hope throughout this crisis.

“You're helping us — this will help our family eat,” Loretha says. “Thank you!”

The demand on Second Harvest's emergency food network has skyrocketed during this pandemic. We've distributed more than 17 million meals since the start of our emergency response. We're so grateful you're helping us keep food on the table for Tennesseans during this challenging time.

# Christopher and Natosha Are Giving Thanks for You

About a year ago, Natosha and her husband, Christopher, took a leap of faith. The couple invested most of their savings in their new cleaning business.

They were having success with both residential and commercial clients. But then there was the COVID-19 outbreak.

“We understand why clients have cancelled,” Christopher says. “It’s a scary time.”

It was jarring and sad to see the business they were building suddenly halt. The couple wasn’t sure what to do.

“When you work for yourself, you have no one to lean back on,” Natosha says.

Unfortunately, because they work for themselves, she and Christopher have been struggling to access unemployment benefits. That’s why they’re so glad they found out about the Second Harvest grocery distribution at McGavock High School near their home in Donelson.

Natalie, 11, lives with her parents and older sister, Olivia, 15, near Gainsboro. She has good insight into her family's situation for her young age.

"We can't go buy a ton of groceries like all these other people can," she says.

Natalie's mom has a disability that keeps her from working, and her dad hasn't been able to make money due to business closures. He's a furniture maker, and the stores that sell his work were shut down for months. The family was relying on savings and retirement funds when they found out about New Hope Baptist Church Care Center, a Second Harvest Partner Agency.

The pantry has been distributing food at a drive-thru at the Jackson County Fairgrounds. Natalie has been worried about contracting the virus — especially since her aunt was infected.

Natalie appreciates the extra steps the pantry is taking to keep her and her family safe, and she loves the food. On a recent visit, Natalie and her mom, Betty, were able to pick up yogurt, apples, and salad to fill their family's table.
