eborah's family has always worked. Asking for assistance does not come easily to her, her husband Jim, or their grown daughter Rachel. But Rachel's prolonged back injury gave them no choice. They needed help.

When Rachel lost her job in home remediation because of her ongoing back issues, Deborah and Jim stepped in to support her. The increased expense has put the couple behind on their bills, and money for food is tight.

"She has been looking for work every day," Deborah says. "But when you have physical limitations, you can't just take any job. She's a hard worker. It's just defeating."



Gladys & Casper Are Living Happier, **Healthier Lives**

ladys and her 20-year-old son Adrian, nicknamed "Casper," have just returned to Nashville from Colorado. There they were seeking special treatment for Casper's developmental issues that impair his ability to communicate verbally. Gladys is Casper's sole caretaker.

Casper's medications and allergies require the family to eat a very special diet of mostly fresh vegetables — foods that Gladys explains are very expensive.

"Fresh food...let's face it," Gladys says, "That's some of the most expensive food on the shelves."

Living on a limited fixed income and without a car, Gladys says that affording and accessing the good vegetables Casper needs to stay healthy is a challenge.

When Gladys heard about the Juneteenth Health & Wellness Fair at Nashville General Hospital, she was excited to attend!

At the fair, the family was able to get a well check visit, health tips, and other benefits provided by Meharry Medical College and United Healthcare.

Additionally, Gladys received a large bag of fresh produce carrots, onions, cabbage, potatoes, and more from Second Harvest.

"It might just be me and Casper," Gladys says, "but I am not doing this alone. All of the help we receive has been amazing. Thank you!"

Forced to Stop Work, John Turns to Second Harvest

ohn spent his entire working life as a corrections officer, but recently a chronic medical condition left him unable to work.

"It wasn't an easy job, but I was good at it," he says, sad to have had no choice but to end his career.

John, his wife, and their child have been living off his wife's income as a hairdresser, but it isn't enough. They're using the savings John built up over his years as a corrections officer, but that won't last forever.

Now, John is waiting for his application for disability benefits to be processed so he and his family can afford to pay bills and buy food each week.

"It's been tough while waiting to see if I can get benefits," he says. "I've

never needed to apply for this stuff before."

And obtaining these benefits isn't easy. In fact, it's quite difficult—the application itself can be confusing, the requirements are strict, and, if one is successful in getting disability benefits, there's a lot of fine print that comes with maintaining them.

No matter what happens with John's benefits, the family is grateful to receive much-needed help from the food pantry at St. Paul Missionary Baptist Church, a Second Harvest Partner Agency that hosts a bi-monthly, drive-thru food pantry.

"The food means a lot and I'm thankful to receive it," John says.
