## ABOUT FOOD 2 FAMILIES

Food 2 Families is an annual food drive founded by WKRN News 2 to engage elementary, middle and high school students in Second Harvest's 46-county service area. Schools compete against each other to see who can collect the most non-perishable food items.

All food collected will benefit Second Harvest Food Bank and its network of 460+ Partner Agencies. **The food your school collects will stay in your county and is used to make food boxes and fill pantry shelves for families and individuals in need.**

## SCHOOL PARTICIPATION

Principals, teachers, PTA volunteers, school clubs, or student organizations can register. Food drive donations are available for pickup at the food bank or for delivery to your school\*. When, how, and where you collect your canned food items is up to you. Have students bring food items to your football games, assign the campaign to the school's clubs, create incentives, and make it fun. Be sure to keep an ongoing total count of food items collected to turn in at the end of your drive!

Deadline for submitting can totals: October 31, 2025

Donation Pickup/Drop Off Deadline: November 7, 2025

Winners Announced: November 12, 2025

## PRIZES

Prizes will be given to the top THREE schools that raise the most items per capita in each category (high school, middle school, and elementary).

- TOP THREE HIGH SCHOOLS: \$1,000
- TOP THREE MIDDLE SCHOOLS: \$500
- TOP THREE ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS: \$500

All prizes are awarded to schools that raise the most items per capita (items raised on average per student).

Every participating school will win the most important prize, which is knowing they made a positive impact on the lives of those in need.

## FOOD DRIVE CHECKLIST

### 1. Register your food drive by going to [secondharvestmidtn.org/food2families](https://secondharvestmidtn.org/food2families)

Complete the Food Drive Registration Form in its entirety to ensure timely food bank follow-up, appropriate box delivery and donation pick-up. YOU MUST FILL OUT THE ONLINE FORM TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE MENTIONED PRIZES.

### 2. Get your food drive boxes\*

Pick up food drive collection boxes at Second Harvest (331 Great Circle Road, Nashville, TN 37228) Monday – Friday between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. If 10 or fewer food drive boxes are needed, we ask that schools pick up the boxes and return them once full. This saves significant staff and transportation dollars, which can then be used to mobilize more food for those in need.

If your donations are being picked up by Second Harvest, all donation boxes must be located on the first floor of your building, near a main entrance. Drivers will not collect boxes from each class room. To schedule a pick-up of your donated items please call Jack at 615-627-1567 or email [food.drives@secondharvestmidtn.org](mailto:food.drives@secondharvestmidtn.org). All donations stay in the county they are raised in.

\*Schools can collect donations in any container and deliver them to Second Harvest **before** November 7, 2025.  
All donations picked up by Second Harvest must be in Second Harvest Food collection boxes, no exceptions.
